

Modern Brock Pickleball League

Categories

Pickleball Singles (Men and Women combined)

Mixed Doubles

Singles and Mixed start date ... Wednesday May 1st

Women's Doubles

Can join the mixed doubles ladder and perhaps at a later date, create their own division.

Men's Doubles

Start date ... As soon as 3 teams are interested in playing.

Intent – To enhance the enjoyment of playing Pickleball by connecting players at their current skill set. Accomplished by creating groupings/round robin play with players advancing up or down the rungs of a ladder depending on their number of wins each schedule.

Recreation Play – The league will provide an opportunity for beginners and/or recreational players to connect and play against others that may not have been possible before.

Competitive Play - The league will provide an opportunity for competitive players the opportunity to be recognized as elite within the Brockville community.

Cost – FREE

Note – a fee may be considered in the future if the league is successful and time/expenses to manage become a factor.

Participate in as many categories as you want and able to play.

Cost – If you are not a member of the Brockville Squash Club, please deposit your \$10 in one of the collection boxes located at the club.

New Players/Teams - Welcome to join at any time.

Rung (Round Robin Groupings) - Will be posted upon the conclusion of scheduled games every other Sunday. Timing of the schedule release will be determined by how late the last games are played on the 2nd Sunday.

Scheduling – Players are responsible for scheduling your own matches. Location, date, and time will be at the discretion of those involved in the match. Players/teams will have 14 days to schedule and play 2 matches. Membership with the Brockville Squash Club is not a requirement to join the league.

Movement of Players/Teams

Generally

- Most wins within a rung will likely move up a rung.
- Less wins within a rung will likely move down a rung.
- **The above is the ideal process but only a guideline.**

New players joining, players not available to play or players returning to the league after being unavailable will influence the above process.

Players could move up or down several rungs depending on number of players opting in or opting out.

Ties - At the completion of round robin play – ties are possible.

- Head-to-head play between those tied
- Number of games lost (fewest)
- Previous position on a ladder rung.
- Names drawn from a hat.

Games

Games played to 11, win by 2 and game will end at 15 points.

A match is 5 games in total unless timed out.

(If timed out on a court – record only completed games)

Timed out – only able to schedule a court for one hour and unable to complete 5 games. Report only completed games.

Prizes – IF prizes are available, the conclusion of each month a draw will be held on the games played the previous schedules. Each game win will result in the player's name or player's team added to the draw.

Reporting Results – The onus of reporting will be the winning player. Report only the number of wins (5-0, 4-1, 3-2, 2-2) State who played and how many games each player/team won. Failure to report a match - 0 wins to all involved in the match.

Matches/Games unable to be played for any reason.

Noted as '0' wins for the match and/or any games not played less than the maximum of 5 games.

Team Play - Substitutions

The intent is to play. If one person isn't available to play, a team can use a replacement player for the match. Best efforts to replace the player with a similar skill set would be appreciated. The replacement player could be a player from another team.

Posting of Results

In the beginning – group email

2 or 4 Players on the same RUNG

3 players per rung will be the target each schedule but on occasion there could be 2 or maybe 4 players scheduled on a rung. IF ... this happens it will generally happen on the 4th or 5th rung of the ladder. See the document on 'common questions' as to how it will be handled.
